1. **Coordinate activities with CAMS, SUP, and Heber Valley Heritage Foundation**

Sons of Utah Pioneers' Harvey Horners started with an explanation of the presentations that the SUP had been holding and reported on the Tom Tabby Monument and work on the Statue in front of the Columbarium of Tom Tabby on his horse. There will be a national encampment for the SUP here in the Heber Valley in September 16–18 2027 and 500 or more participants are expected. SUP are also working on a scholarship and opened the application to graduating seniors.

Heber Valley Heritage Foundation and the Just Serve Foundation's Michael Moulton presented on their work since the last meeting. They will be working with Mike Bradshaw to bring back the London Springs living history site according to Raymond Greens vision as outlined in his history book. They are also looking at Sessions Springs near River Road, and it has become more important with the Slope development that will be happening in that area.

6. Training (Jacob)

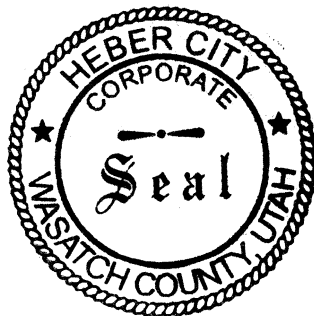
Jacob presented a Training slideshow for the Commission, delivering information on the City Code, Current Membership, the Commission Duties, and showed the Cultural Heritage District
